Preliminary Eligibility Requirements for Nebraska Transition College:

To fulfill our mission to empower our students to live interdependently through employment and community support systems, our candidates must meet these initial entrance requirements*:

- 1. Prospective students must hold, or will obtain, a high school diploma. Students may begin taking courses during their senior year if approved by the school district.**
- 2. Prospective students will have a verified disability.**
- 3. Prospective students must not have a chronic history of arrest or probation. Student must not have a persistent pervasive behavior documented within the school setting or a history of inflicting harm on self or others.**
- 4. Prospective students must be able to manage daily activities including personal hygiene, grooming and dressing without one-on-one supervision.**
- 5. Prospective students must be able to function without 24-hour supervision in a residential setting.**
- 6. Prospective students must be able to recognize when s/he needs assistance.**
- 7. Prospective students must have a desire for competitive employment or other post-secondary educational opportunity at the end of the NTC program.**
- 8. Prospective students must make a commitment to be an active participant in the NTC program.**

* NTC strives for an inclusive student body. This is not an exhaustive list of eligibility requirements. NTC staff will review all submitted documentation and consider any analysis of an interview if one was offered before determining appropriateness of placement into our programming.
